State Administrative Penalty Authority

- Notice of Violation
- Alleged Violations Letter
- Administrative Penalty Order
- Stipulation Agreement
- Notice of Violation (NOV)
- Alleged Violations Letter (AVL)
- Request for Information (RFI)



State Administrative Penalty Authority (continued)

- Administrative Penalty Order (APO)
- Minnesota Statute 116.072
 - Forgivable/Nonforgivable
 - Corrective Actions
 - Generally Not Negotiable
- Administrative Penalty Order Appeal Options
 - Administrative Law Judge
 - District Court



State Administrative Penalty Authority (continued)

Stipulation Agreement

- Civil Penalty Determination Process
- Negotiation
- Press Release

SEC Reporting

Penalties above threshold need to be reported

- Order Authority
- Criminal Referral
- Referral to State or Federal Authorities
